

West Aurora Parent Organization Scholarship Application & Cover Sheet

This scholarship will be awarded to West Aurora High School graduating seniors who plan to attend a college, university, trade or vocational school. The number of scholarships to be awarded, as well as the amount of each scholarship, will be determined by the West Aurora PTSO.

Eligibility Requirements:

- 1. The applicant is to be a graduating senior or mid-year graduate at the time the scholarship is awarded in May.
- 2. The applicant, a parent or guardian must be a PTSO member for the current school year. If none are current members, applicants **must** submit a completed **PTSO membership form** and **dues** with their scholarship application. A membership form can be accessed from the PTSO page on West Aurora High School's website.
- 3. The applicant is to complete and return the scholarship application cover sheet and essay by February 3, 2020.
- 4. The applicant's cumulative GPA must be 2.5 or better to apply.
- 5. If a candidate who receives a West Aurora Parent Organization Scholarship also receives the honor of a full scholarship to his/her college, university, trade or vocational school of choice, the candidate will decline the West Aurora Parent Organization Scholarship so that another worthy graduating senior may receive it.

Submission Requirements:

The applicant must write an essay of 1,000 words or less double spaced in 12 pt. Times New Roman regarding his/her:

- o Involvement in extra-curricular activities
- o Community service or Work Experience
- o Career objectives and future plans
- o Influence from school activities provided by PTSO/PTO/PTA

Scholarship Application Evaluation:

- 1. A committee of District 129 PTSO/PTO/PTA members will evaluate each application.
- 2. The committee will evaluate the overall quality of each application based on the eligibility and submission requirements listed above.
- 3. To maintain anonymity in the selection process, the Scholarship Committee Chairperson will assign a special code number to each application and redact any names in the essay.
- 4. GPA and class rank will be used only in the event of a tie.
